REMAND ORDER

On January 12, 2021, the respondents, Richard Jeffries, et al., by counsel, W. Stuart Calwell, L. Danté diTrapano and Alex McLaughlin, Calwell Luce DiTrapano, PLLC; Van Bunch, Bonnett Fairbourn Freidman & Balint, PC; and Kevin Thompson and David R. Barney, Thompson Barney, filed a motion to remand, for the reasons set forth. On January 22, 2021 the petitioner, West Virginia-American Water Company, by counsel, Thomas J. Hurney, Jr. and Alexandra Kitts, Jackson Kelly, PLLC; and Kent Mayo, Baker Botts LLP, filed a response in opposition to the motion.

Upon consideration and review, the Court is of the opinion to and does grant the motion to remand. It is therefore ordered that this case shall be, and it hereby is, remanded to the Honorable Carrie L. Webster, Judge of the Circuit Court of Kanawha County, and the Circuit Court of Kanawha County for further consideration in light of *State of West Virginia ex rel. Surnaik Holdings of WV, LLC v. Bedell*, No. 19-1006, W.Va. (Nov. 20, 2020).

It is finally ordered that this matter shall be, and it hereby is, dismissed from the docket of this Court.

Chief Justice Evans H. Jenkins and Justice Tim Armstead would refuse the motion to remand.
